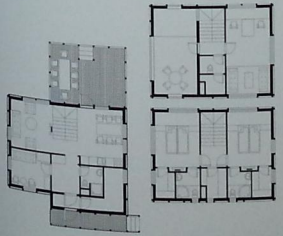
Russian Wood Patchwork House "Dacha"

The artistic design of this house is a combination of a simple layout with a clear function and a façade composed of wooden patchworks of various shapes and colors. The design envisaged a comfortable living space for two adult couples and their grown-up children. The program also required ample space to accommodate guests. On the ground floor are the kitchen and adjoining dining room, a guest room, the boiler room, a summer veranda and a bathroom. The first floor consists of two bedrooms, two wardrobe rooms, a washing room, two toilets and shower rooms, while the work shop or studio, sauna, summer veranda, toilet and shower room are all located on the second floor.



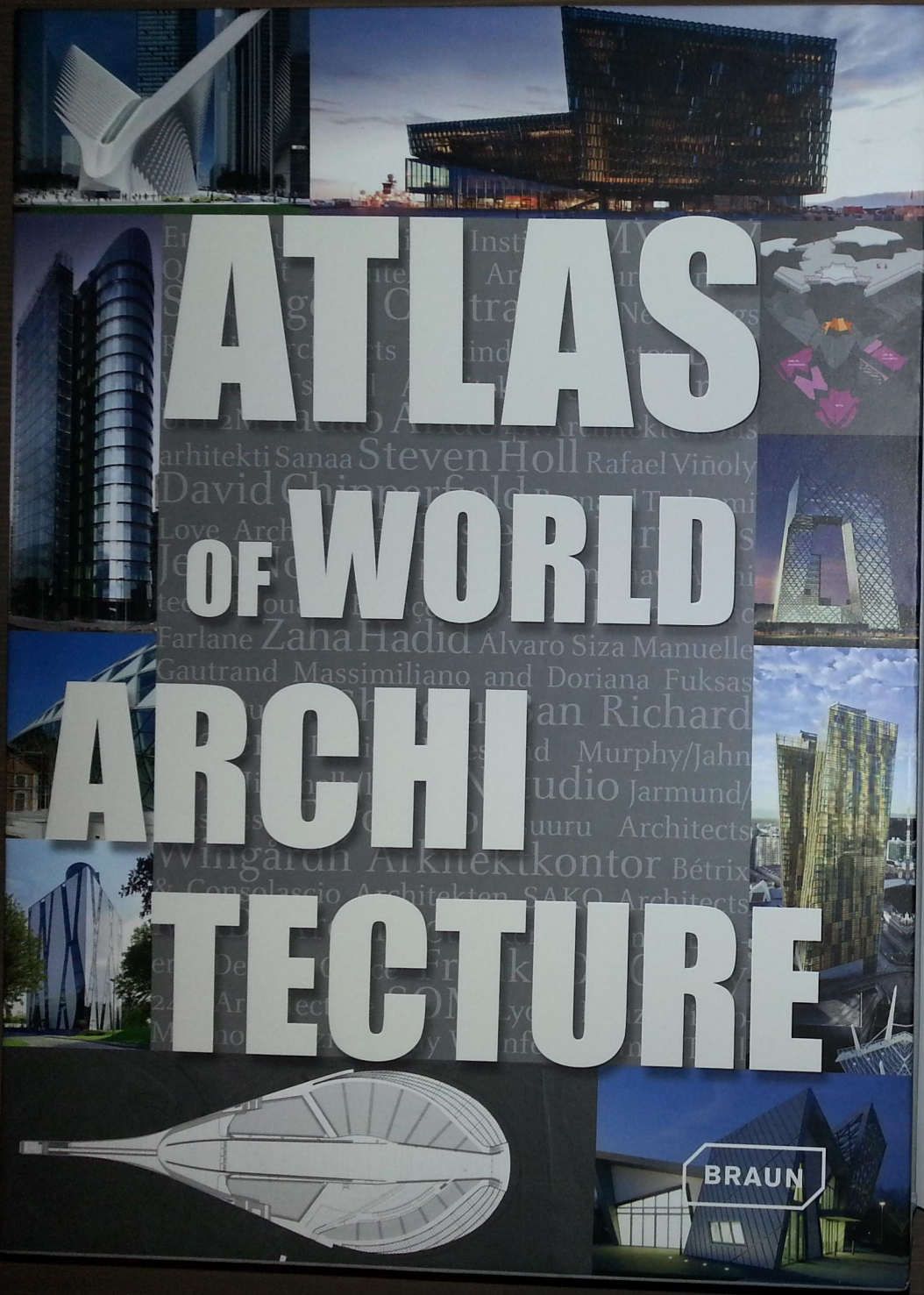
